7. Others (proposals sent to Implementation group on **September 15 at the latest** only; matters proposed at the venue will be discuss only if there is enough time)

The representative must be a citizen of the country, which represents! Other WTHA members may take a part at the session as well (if there is enough space). Only representatives can discuss and vote.
